SULLIVAN COUNTY COMPLEX WATER SYSTEM UNITY, NEW HAMPSHIRE

General

In 2019 Sullivan County Officials developed an Asset Management Plan for the Sullivan County Complex Water System in Unity, NH. Asset Management is defined as meeting the service levels that customers expect at the lowest possible life-cycle cost and at an acceptable level of risk.

An Asset Management Plan provides the following information to assist municipalities:

- ✓ Current State of the System
- ✓ Required Level of Service
- ✓ Critical Components
- ✓ Asset Investment Strategies
- ✓ Funding Strategies

There are several benefits of an Asset Management Plan, including:

- ✓ Confidence in decision making
- ✓ Justify need for investments to public
- ✓ Transition from reactive to proactive management
- ✓ Assists with budgeting based on sound information

Components Inventoried and Assessed

Dufresne Group was contracted to inventory and assess all components of the water treatment and distribution system. A summary of the water system assets within the Sullivan County Water System is as follows


Source / Treatment Building: 3
Tanks: 2
Fire Water Storage Ponds: 2
Water Mains: 3.8 Miles
Valves: 36
Hydrants: 8
