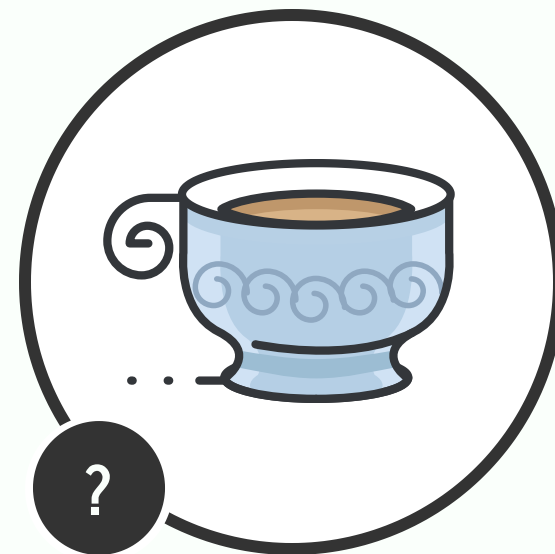


# Improving Access & Inclusion for People with Disabilities Trainings
