

INVITATION TO BID

Sullivan County invites sealed bids from qualified contractors for parking lot improvements for the Newport Parking Lot, Newport, NH until **noon on April 26, 2017** at the Office of the County Manager, 14 Main Street, Newport, NH 03773 at which time and place all Bids will be publicly opened and read. Bids submitted after this time or those that do not comply with the bid requirements will not be accepted.

The construction work includes grading, paving, striping, drainage systems, site lighting, landscaping, sidewalks, signs and miscellaneous work to construct the Newport Parking Lot in Newport, NH.

A pre-bid conference will be held **April 13, 2017 at 9:00 AM** at the Office of the County Manager, 14 Main Street, Newport, NH 03773 to discuss the project details. All bidders are encouraged to attend.

Each Bid shall be accompanied by a bid security in the form of a certified, treasurer's or cashier's check or Bid Bond in the sum of five (5) percent of the Bid Price.

No Bidder may withdraw his/her Bid for a period of 60 days after the actual date of the opening of the Bids.
