Present: Dave French, Comm. Jarvis, Comm. Nelson, Comm. Barrette, Greg
Chanis, Paul Brown left the Conference Room to return at 10:30 for
next interview.

Commissioners and Greg discussed RSA's of Equipment Account to be used by the Register of Deeds. In question was the complete restoration of 1885 indexes and deeds that were burned in a fire. Restoration of these volumes has been an ongoing project. Could some of the money in the equipment fund be used for the restoration of 8 volumes bringing this project to completion. The final bill would be \$24,000 @ \$3,000 per volume. The Register of Deeds had requested the \$24,000 to come out of the ongoing budget, but only \$12,000 was budgeted. Commissioner Jarvis felt we should not go off budget. The decision as to what to do will be at our next regular scheduled meeting Jan. 22, 2009.

Greg informed us that Mr. Purdy (County Health Care Administrator) will not be at the Jan. 22, 2009 meeting due to a conference he will be attending. Greg will give the report.

Sheriff Prozzo approached the Commissioners with a proposal. Sheriff Prozzo had previously approached Greg with this proposal. Strafford County has a 12-passenger van for sale, 103,000 miles; set up for transport; Year 2003; has cage; cost \$3,500. Discussion followed by commissioners. Comm. Barrette asked if we could use it and how much would it be used? After much discussion the Commissioner decided to buy the van. Seemed like a very good deal.

Motion made by Comm. Barrette to purchase the vehicle 2003 12-passenger van from Strafford County for \$3500 upon visual inspection as advertised. Seconded by Commissioner Nelson. All were in favor.

Greg informed the Commissioners that it was time for the next interview.

Motion made to come out of public session at 10:00 by Commissioner Nelson, Seconded by Comm. Jarvis. All were in favor
