## Culvert work to begin Monday

UNITY — The New Hampshire Department of Transportation will start construction to replace a 4-foot wide by 3-foot high concrete box culvert just south of the intersection with the Second New Hampshire Turnpike in Unity.

Work is expected to begin on Monday by removing the existing box culvert, which is in poor condition. A steel 5-foot by 3-foot pipe arch will be installed in its place.

County Farm Road will be closed to through traffic at the Second New Hampshire

Turnpike intersection on or about Aug. 11, at 6 a.m. until 6 p.m. Traffic will be detoured around the work via West Unity Road. Variable message boards will be utilized. One-way alternating traffic will be necessary afterward to complete the work. Flaggers will be utilized to guide motorists through the construction.

The Department of Transportation's Highway Maintenance District 2 will be constructing the approximately \$20,000 culvert replacement project.
