Executive Session – Personnel Issue

Attendees: Commissioners Donald S. Clarke – *Chair*, Ben C. Nelson – *Vice-Chair* (arrived later) and Ethel Jarvis – *Clerk*; Ed Gil de Rubio – *County Manager*; Sharon Johnson-Callum (*minute taker*)

11:17 A motion was made, by Commissioner Nelson, to go in to Executive Session for a Personnel Issue [Per RSA 91-A:3.II.c.] Commissioner Jarvis seconded the motion. There was no discussion. A roll call vote was taken. The motion carried, unanimously.

11:17 All left the meeting except the three Commissioners, Mr. Gil de Rubio and Sharon Johnson-Callum.

11:17 – 11:23 Short recess of meeting taken.

11:23 Mr. Gil de Rubio passed out a political flyer posted on Stearns II/III, of the Sullivan County Health Care (no copy given to minute-taker). He allowed the Board to take time to read through it. He noted the item was either posted by an employee or former employee, and, was not appropriate to be posted in County buildings. Commissioner Jarvis confirmed she had seen the flyer at an event she attended, where it was passed out, and indicated she had just filed it “away”. Commissioner Clarke concurred it was not appropriate to be posted on County bulletin boards. Mr. Gil de Rubio noted Union Officials are deadly against these type postings. He noted, if Commissioner Jarvis knows who is doing this, it needed to be expressed to them that they are placing the employment of County employees at risk. Commissioner Clarke noted the flyer personally noted he was “Out of touch”, and finds it repulsive. Mr. Gil de Rubio noted he and Mr. Farrand, the Human Resource Director, will be drafting policy dealing with this issue for future reference, and, in the meantime, a full investigation, under his guidance would be conducted.

11:33 A motion was made, by Commissioner Nelson, to move out of Executive Session. Commissioner Jarvis seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. A voice vote was taken. The motion carried, unanimously.
